

Power and Organisation

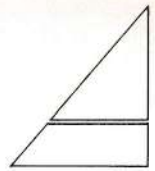
as this is a dimension strongly influencing evere OE-work. So we should like to suggest this theme for our next meeting.

Well, I think that covers all at the moment. I am confident to receive your answers in due time, also if they should be negative. This is as well important as positive ones!

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
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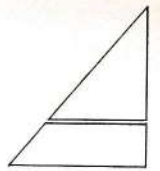
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
